



ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW

Please review all of this information to ensure that you and your student(s) are completely prepared before recital.

ATTIRE

Hair:

Hair must be parted down the middle and pulled back into a low bun. Hair must be completely sleeked back, no fly aways. You should use hair spray or hair gel to do so. Low buns can be made with Perfect Buns or donuts, but can just be a twisted bun as well. All dancers should wear a hair net over their bun that matches their hair color. (Sally's in Ottawa supplies these). Hair ties and bobby pins should also match the dancer's hair color. Absolutely no hair sparkles.

Makeup:

Neutral colors (brown-scale) for eyeshadow. Preferably a smokey eye (darker towards the outside of the lid). Blush, mascara, and cranberry lipstick (Maybelline 660 is a favorite) must be worn by everyone. Anyone over the age of 6 must wear black eyeliner. Eyelashes are required for Junior and senior company.

Costumes:

All students will wear their respected costumes for each dance. You may drink water while in your costumes but no other liquids or food may be consumed while in costume. Steam your child's costumes before dress rehearsal. If you do not have a steamer, hang the costumes upside down on a hanger in the shower to release wrinkles. Costumes should be carried on hangers in garment bags to and from the school. All students need Body Wrappers jazzy tan color tights for their performances. Make sure you have a backup in case a tight tears during the show. No underwear should be worn under tights. Only tan bras, either strapless or clear strapped, will be allowed. If hair piece came with the costumes verify with your child's instructor if they will be worn or not. Costumes cannot come home with your child until your account is paid in full.

Shoes:

Make sure your child has the appropriate shoes for their dances. This includes the correct color. Ballet and pointe shoe strings should be tucked in for performances. If the dancer has convertible tights, make sure their tights are over their toes in shoes.

Jazz shoes – Bloch super jazz in tan

Tap shoes – black

Ballet shoes – pink

PICTURE DAY

Picture day is May 18th. Pictures will be taken at the studio. Please see the attached schedule for your child's time. Hair and make up are up to the discretion of the parent. *Company: please wear your hair in middle part/low bun.*

ADMISSION

Times:

Tech rehearsal is Wednesday June 5th at 4:00 pm. See attached schedule for times.

Dress rehearsal is Thursday June 6th at 4:00 pm. We will be running the show in order.

Recital: June 7th at 7:00 pm and June 8th at 3:00pm

- 1st Act dancers: report to dressing rooms no later than one hour before showtime.
- 2nd Act dancers: report to dressing rooms no later than showtime.

LOCATION:

Seneca High School 307 E. Scott Street, Seneca, IL

TICKETS:

Tickets are required for admission. Ticket orders are due to the office by April 12th. We are having reserved seating, so if you have a preference, please indicate it on your form, and turn your form in ASAP. Ticket orders will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. If there are still tickets available, we will have them for purchase at the door. Tickets are \$14/adult and \$10 for kids ages 3-11. 2 and under are free if they sit on a lap.

EXPECTATIONS:

Bows:

Students are encouraged to participate in the bows at the end of the show. If your student wishes to join us, we will practice bows right before dress rehearsal begins on Thursday. Bows will take place at the end of each show.

Dress Rehearsal:

Hair, makeup, and costumes will be worn exactly as they will for show day. It's imperative you come completely ready. This ensures that you and your student are completely prepared for show day. This also allows you, your students, and the staff to identify and correct any issues that may occur. This helps the dancers feel comfortable on stage as well.

Show day:

Dancers should be dressed and warmed up/stretched 30 minutes prior to their performance times. (Assume that each dance is about 2.5 minutes long). The show will start promptly and we will not wait if your child is not ready.

Dressing room etiquette:

Make sure you pick up after yourself and leave the room better than you found it. Students should remain in the dressing room until they are called backstage. The dressing room is for costume changes, but should also be used for warm up and stretching areas. Costume racks are encouraged as we may not have much hanging space at the school. There is a volunteer form attached if you would like to work backstage. Please fill out and give to Julie by 4/12.

Back stage etiquette:

No parents will be allowed backstage unless specifically requested by the faculty. Students will only be allowed backstage two numbers before their dance and will return to their designated dressing rooms right after. Talking is prohibited backstage.

Theatre etiquette:

Students should not wear their costumes in the theatre without being covered up. Only enter and exit the theatre in-between dances. Photo and video will be allowed during dress rehearsal ONLY, not during the shows. Absolutely no flash, it is both distracting and disrespectful to the dancers and audience members. Videos will be available for purchase as summer classes begin.

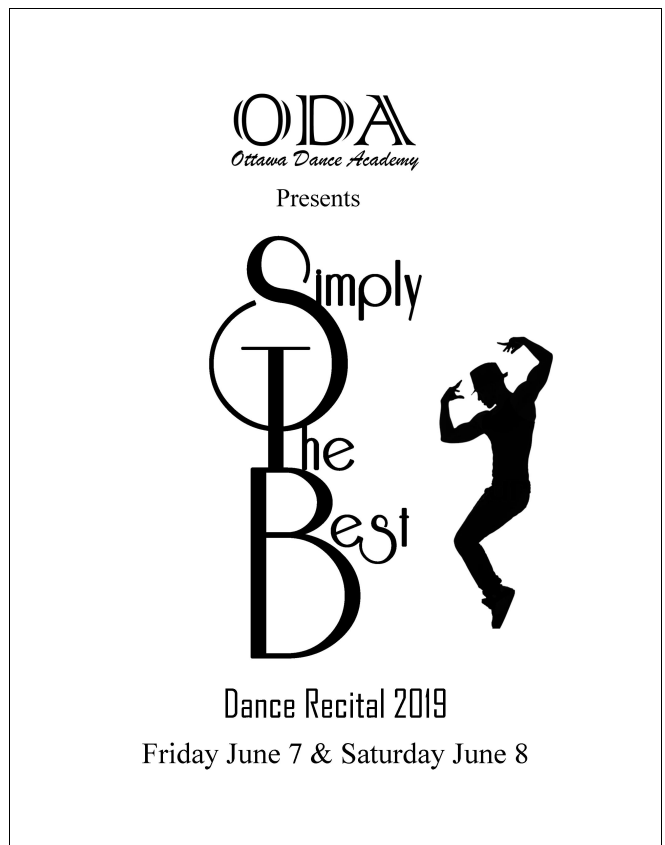
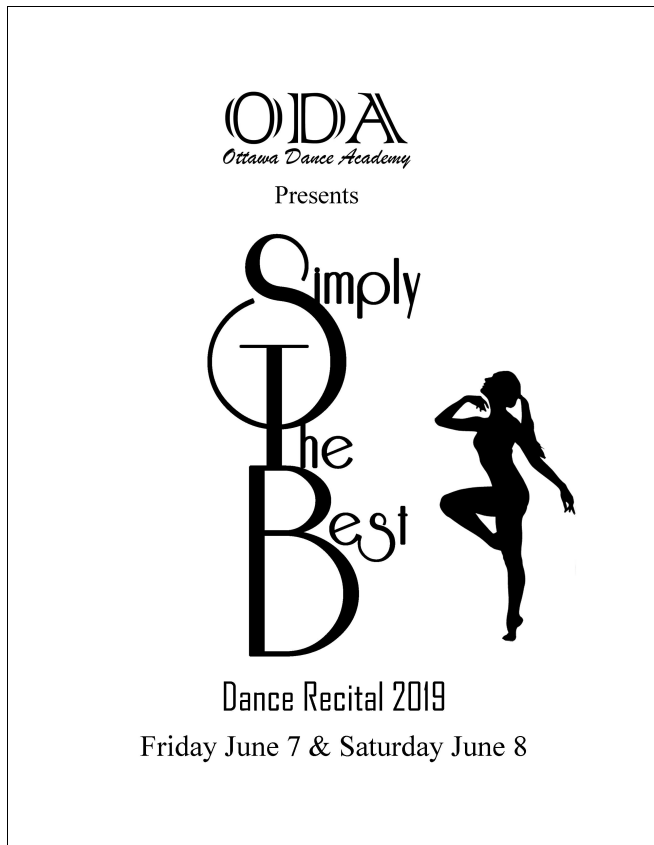
